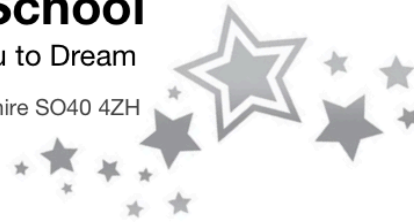

Dear Parent

In assembly on Monday, we explored the importance of respect. Following discussions with our School Pupil Voice, we have identified respectful behaviour towards adults as the focus of our next Behaviour Hot Spot, running from Monday 15th June to Friday 19th June.

Respectful behaviour helps us to build a caring, safe and happy school community. When children greet adults politely, listen carefully and follow instructions, it helps everything run smoothly and shows kindness and consideration to those who support them every day. These small actions make a big difference to the atmosphere in school and help children develop positive habits for life.

Children who demonstrate respectful behaviour during the Hot Spot will be rewarded with a token to enter a draw for a special reward time. The more tokens they earn, the greater their chance of being selected from the box.

We also want to encourage children to show these same positive behaviours in the wider community. With this in mind, we have extended our Hot Spot. We have shared vouchers with our local Co-op and bakers, and children will receive a voucher for demonstrating positive behaviour in these settings too. These vouchers can be placed into the token box, giving children another chance to be selected for the prize.
